04 Complete all paperwork and receive your KEYS!! Refer another veteran who could use the same help



We will assess your situation and make the appropriate referrals which will best suit your needs.



We can help source options to prevent evictions and find available emergency financial assistance in order to remain housed.



VST works closely with VA housing programs along with local and national programs to assist homeless veterans with access to quality shelter and safe housing options.

- Working with community partners to provide a pathway for our peers toward long term housing and recovery programs.
- Fostering contact with each peer to create, maintain and develop the relationship. This relationship with the VST Peer Support Team is vital to create a long lasting approach within the community.
